Photography & Geology amid Oregon's most colorful landscapes.

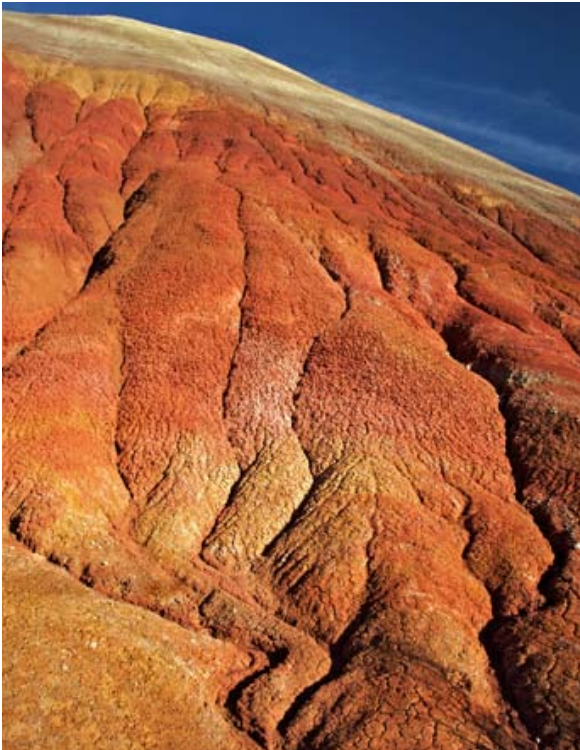

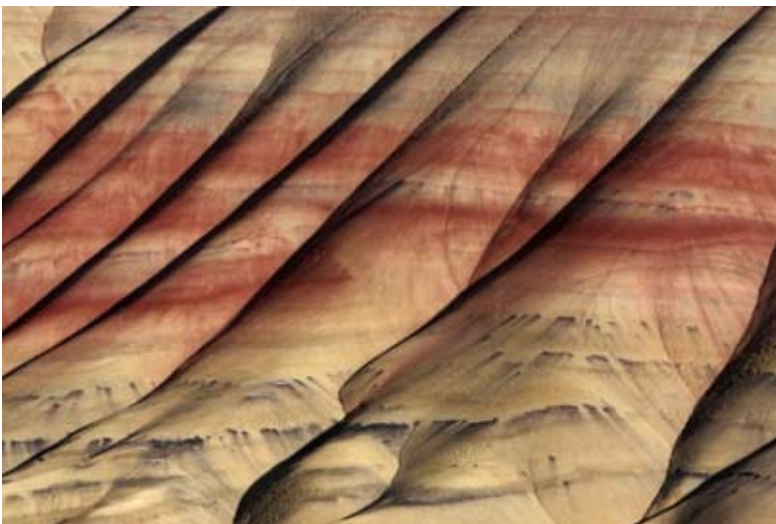
### SATURDAY: MAY 9: 7 AM-6 PM:
